## Colorado Indigent Care Program (CICP)

We administer the Colorado Indigent Care Program (CICP), which provides discounted health care services to low-income people and families. **CICP is not a health insurance program.** Discounted health care services are provided by Colorado hospitals and clinics that participate in the CICP.

### Informacion para el programa CICP

#### Who Qualifies?

- People legally residing in Colorado
- People who meet income and resource guidelines
- People who are not eligible for Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program) or Child Health Plan *Plus* (CHP+)
- People who are covered by Medicare or who have other health insurance may be eligible for CICP.

Examples of CICP approximate income limits:

Family Size	Approximate Annual Income	Approximate Monthly Income
1	up to \$31,900	up to \$2,658
2	up to \$43,100	up to \$3,592
3	up to \$54,300	up to \$4,525
4	up to \$65,500	up to \$5,458

#### How To Apply

- You must provide personal identification, household income and resource information for you and your family.
- You may call a participating CICP provider to schedule an appointment to complete the application process.

## Benefits and Services

- Emergency care is discounted at hospitals that participate in the CICP.
- Since CICP is **not health insurance**, medical services discounted under CICP may be different at each participating hospital or clinic.
  - Some providers may discount urgent care, inpatient hospital care, primary care and prescription drugs.
- All applications must be completed within 90 days of the date of service.

## What Does CICP Cost?

- You are responsible for co-payments for services you receive.
  - Co-payments will vary depending on the medical services you receive.
- Your family's income and resources determine what you pay.
- You are responsible for medical services or tests not discounted by your CICP provider.
- Your CICP discount only applies to services received by a qualified CICP provider.
- Your CICP discount applies after any health insurance you might have.
- You pay the lower of remaining charges that your health insurance does not cover, or the CICP co-payment, whichever amount is lower.

## Does CICP Count As Health Insurance?

**No, CICP is not health insurance program.** As of 2014, if you or your family are currently enrolled in CICP, **you might now be eligible for Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program)**.
